NOTES

DAY 1

Bike: Rent a bike for free at Tosa Terrace. It is safe to use an electric bicycle in eco-mode except on uphill slopes!

Baggage: Ask for baggage storage. Pick up your baggage when you return the bike.

Suigei (meaning Drunken Whale) Brewery: Sign up for a brewery tour and receive free tasting and an original boar cup. Reservations available online. https://suigei.co.jp/brewery/tour

Kiyotakiji: The steep and extremely narrow path is said to be the steepest of the 88 sacred sites! Don't miss the ceiling of the Niomon Gate, which has a "dragon in all directions" painted in 1900. In the main hall, visitors can take a free "kairan (tour of the Buddhist altar)" and experience a pitch-dark world. The tour takes about 5 minutes.
