NOTES
<p>DAY 1 Leave from Matsuyama Station by JR bus → Kuma Junior High School Daihoji: This temple is located at the midpoint of the 88 Sacred Sites on Shikoku Island on a pathway surrounded by several centuries-old giant cedars, with an atmosphere that is quiet and dignified.</p> <p>Furuiwaya: A popular spot for viewing the autumn leaves. A place of worship for ascetic practitioners since ancient times, there is a worship hall along the trail and Momijidani route, and Fudo Myoo (Acala) is enshrined in a huge hole in the rock.</p>
<p>DAY 2 Iwayaji: A sacred mountain site with a unique rocky landscape and a main hall that looks as if it is embedded in the huge rock cliff. Daishi Hall is decorated with roses and incorporates western-style architecture. Seriwari Zenjo: ❶Climb up a cleft in the rock! ❷Climb a precipice with the help of chains! ❸Climb a terrifying ladder!</p> <p>Kayo-chan's House: Henro salon, free rest. Come and meet Kayo-chan! Sakamoto-ya: Osettai on Saturdays and Sundays.</p>
<p>DAY 3 There are 8 Sacred Sites (T46-T43) in Matsuyama, so please visit as many as your time permits.</p> <p>Dogo Onsen: One of the three oldest hot springs in Japan with a nostalgic retro atmosphere. Dogo Onsen's three public bathhouses, Dogo Onsen Honkan, Tsubaki no Yu, and Asuka no Onsen, are publicly operated, but officially allow people with tattoos to bathe in them.</p>
<p>DAY 4 Bike: Rent a bike for the day at Cycle Station Monkeys. Return it to the same location.</p> <p>Dogo Park: Yuzuki Castle existed for 250 years from the early 14th century to the late 16th century, and part of the castle wall still remains.</p> <p>Matsuyama Castle: From the top of the mountain, you can look out over the city and the Seto Inland Sea.</p>
