<p>DAY 0 Stay: Check in at Bed N Chill the night before. Bike: Borrow a bike from Norman at Cycle Shikoku at Bed N Chill.</p>
<p>DAY 1 Use electric bike and return it to Bed N Chill. Zenigata Sunae Sand Art: It is said that if you see the coin, you will have a long healthy life with no problem about money. T68 and T69: Located on the same site and one Nokyocho will provide stamps for both. The observatory deck for Zenigata Sunae is just a few minutes' walk behind the temple. Chichibugahama Beach: 1km-long beach known for beautiful sunsets and spectacular views. Kamonokoshi Beach: You can walk across to Maruyama Island on the opposite shore at low tide.</p> <p>Mt. Shiudeyama: It is such a scenic spot that traffic is restricted during the cherry blossom season. If you want to try cycling up, please note that the altitude is 352m.</p>
<p>DAY 2 Baggage: Check in at Iroha Kaikan (shukubo of T75 Zentsuji) and leave your baggage.</p> <p>If you visit Konpira Shrine, rent a bike at the Community Center, Oshaberi Hiroba. Rental hours are 9:00-16:00, and you must return the bike by 18:00. At Oshaberi Hiroba, fill out the bicycle rental application form.</p>
<p>DAY 3 Morning at the temple starts early. The Buddhist ceremony starts at 5:30. Since you are here, we recommend that you get up early and experience it for yourself!</p>
